Waste Bins

Rye Foreshore Reserve & Rye Carnival Site

Rye Foreshore Reserve Site	9 x General Waste 3 x Recycling
Rye Carnival Site	2 x General Waste 0 x Recycling
<i>All bins are 240L</i>	

How to calculate how many bins are needed for your event:

If food and drinks are provided, in general 1 person will create 1L of waste.

Sample Event:

1,000 people = 1,000L of waste.

1 wheelie bin is 240L

$1000 / 240 = 4$ bins (2 rubbish + 2 recycling)

Equal number of each waste stream is required

All bins must be clearly labelled as appropriate
