

# Major repairs to Portsea beach seawall

Project Update – 17 June 2020

Repair works to the Portsea sandbag seawall are on the home straight with completion expected between late June and early July.

A geotechnical investigation of the cliffs immediately east of the sandbag seawall identified significant instability risks affecting public safety. To address this, the Mornington Peninsula Shire has provided an alternative beach access point opposite Norfolk Drive.

DELWP does not have plans to install additional protective structures on Portsea Front Beach.

With the sandbag seawall nearing completion, toe rocks are progressively being reinstated, starting at the eastern end of the beach. These will help to protect the base of the sandbag seawall. The surplus rock from the bund is being removed.
