

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Do the smart parking sensors identify individuals or their vehicle?**

The in-ground parking sensors only detect whether a vehicle parked over them or not which indicates that the parking bay is occupied or available. The sensors do not detect or record any information about the driver, passengers, or vehicle.

### **Do the smart parking sensors automatically issue infringements for vehicles that park longer than the parking time limits?**

The smart parking sensors do not automatically issue infringements for vehicles that overstay the parking time limits. However, as compliance with time limits is vital for equitable and fair access to parking within the Mornington activity centre, if data from the sensors indicates a pattern of vehicles parking beyond the parking time limits, traffic officers may increase patrols in these areas.

### **Does the smart parking trial involve the implementation of paid parking?**

The Mornington Smart Parking Trial is not related to paid parking.
