

Eligibility

The Outings and Excursion program provides transport to visit venues of interest for individuals who are assessed as Home and Community Care Program for Younger People (HACC PYP) or Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) eligible:

- Frail, older people
- People with a disability (and their carer)

And who:

- do not have the capacity to attend similar outings
- live in remote and isolated areas
- are socially isolated

Note: Passengers using the service need to be independent and mobile (mobility aids accommodated).
