PROPOSED COUNCIL PLAN SUBMISSION: DECISION

Thank you for your submission on the proposed Council Plan 2017-2021, received 28 March 2017.

All submissions were considered by Council in accordance with section 223 of the *Local Government Act 1989* (the Act). The purpose of this letter is to notify you of Council's decision and the reasons for that decision.

Council adopted the Council Plan 2017-2021 at its meeting of 13 June 2017 at Rosebud. No changes were made to the proposed Council Plan as a result of your submission, which did not make any specific requests or proposals. Other changes to the proposed Council Plan were made.

As your submission was understood to be concerned particularly with the major initiative to "build a pool for the community of the Southern Peninsula", the following advice is provided:

Mornington Peninsula Shire Council has indicated that it is a priority to consider the options available for an aquatic centre in Rosebud.

The community's interest in having an aquatic centre in Rosebud was one of the main topics to emerge from the recent Your Peninsula 2021 consultation project.

The new Council has indicated it will consider the options available for an aquatic centre in Rosebud and recently received a briefing on the work undertaken on this project.

Following on-going consultation between officers and the Council in the coming weeks, more details will be released to the community.
