PROPOSED COUNCIL PLAN SUBMISSION: DECISION

Thank you for your submission on the proposed Council Plan 2017-2021, received 19 April 2017.

All submissions were considered by Council in accordance with section 223 of the *Local Government Act 1989* (the Act). The purpose of this letter is to notify you of Council's decision and the reasons for that decision.

Council adopted the Council Plan 2017-2021 at its meeting of 13 June 2017 at Rosebud. No changes were made to the proposed Council Plan directly in response to your submission. Other changes to the proposed Council Plan were made.

The following advice is provided in response to your submission regarding preserving the 70/30 land use mix between rural and residential, limits on subdivisions and prevention of over-development:

There is no proposal to move the Urban Growth Boundary on the Mornington Peninsula. Furthermore, the recently released State Government planning strategy, Plan Melbourne, gives a commitment to accommodate growth within the existing Urban Growth Boundary.

Council is committed to delivering the Housing and Settlement strategy within this term of Council. This strategy will focus on where Council will allow sympathetic development and where we need to restrict residential growth.
