The following advice is provided in response to your submission regarding Dromana foreshore having fewer rubbish bins than Safety Beach:

The Dromana Foreshore is managed by the Dromana Foreshore Committee of Management (DFCoM). The DFCoM is appointed and funded by the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) under the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978* to manage this foreshore reserve. The DFCoM is responsible for the maintenance and management of 3.5 kilometres of beach and foreshore reserve including the provision of street litter bins along the Dromana Foreshore.
