Purpose

Riders who wish to ride and be involved in jump refinement must agree to the following code of conduct.

Key principles- dirt jumps

- Dirt jumps will only be built or modified:
 - At this authorised Council dirt jump site
 - By riders who are registered with Council have signed a waiver
 - Within the scale, line and number of jumps established with the trail builders at each site by the Council
 - Within the area indicated within the site map below
- Jumps are for everyone
- All participants must show respect to all users both the jumps and the broader reserve

I agree to the following conduct:

I will not:

- Build jumps outside the authorised area, or with soil not supplied by Council
- Extend or alter the line or the number of jumps
- Use a motorised bike or vehicle at this site
- Bring any ramps, structures, or furniture onto the site
- Create holes or channels or dig into or move any soil from the surrounding area
- Damage, remove or pick any vegetation or part of a tree or plant on the site

- Use the jumps when they are wet as this will cause damage and may affect the safety of users
- Include branches logos or other objects other than dirt in jumps

I will:

- Only use the soil provided to build and maintain the facility (if I have registered to do so)
- Check for hazards before I ride and report them to 1300 850 600
- Keep the site clean and put rubbish in the bin or take it home
- Come to the site with a companion who can render assistance in the case of an accident or emergency
- Only use the jump during daylight hours
- Always wear a helmet when riding
- Ride the jumps in the direction they have been designed for
- Respect all users, regardless of skill level, gender, age, or background
- Take turns and not cut in on others
- Comply with all safety instructions and protocol notified by Council, from time to time

I understand:

- Trails or jumps constructed outside the authorised areas, or with other dirt or found objects will be removed

Jump construction

Trails and jumps can only be constructed in the area authorised, as shown in Site / Authorised area detailed in the maps below.

- Trails or jumps constructed outside the authorised areas will be removed.
- There must be clear jump lines that accommodate level 1, level 2 and level 3 users. These must remain within the parameters set out below

Jump line designation	Jump height maximum	Gap jumps	Tabletop maximum height	Roller Maximum height	Berm
Level 1	.5 m	No	.5 m	.5 m	No
Level 2	0.8m	No	0.8m	0.8m	Yes
Level 3	1.5 m	Yes	1.5m	1.5m	Yes

- The authorised trail building company will only use the soil provided to build and maintain the facility
- Authorised jump sites will be monitored by the trail builders, and guidance offered, and facilities modified if found to be outside the guidelines
- No tools are to be kept on site
- Tool will always be turned over or placed upright against a tree where instructed, and when not in use
