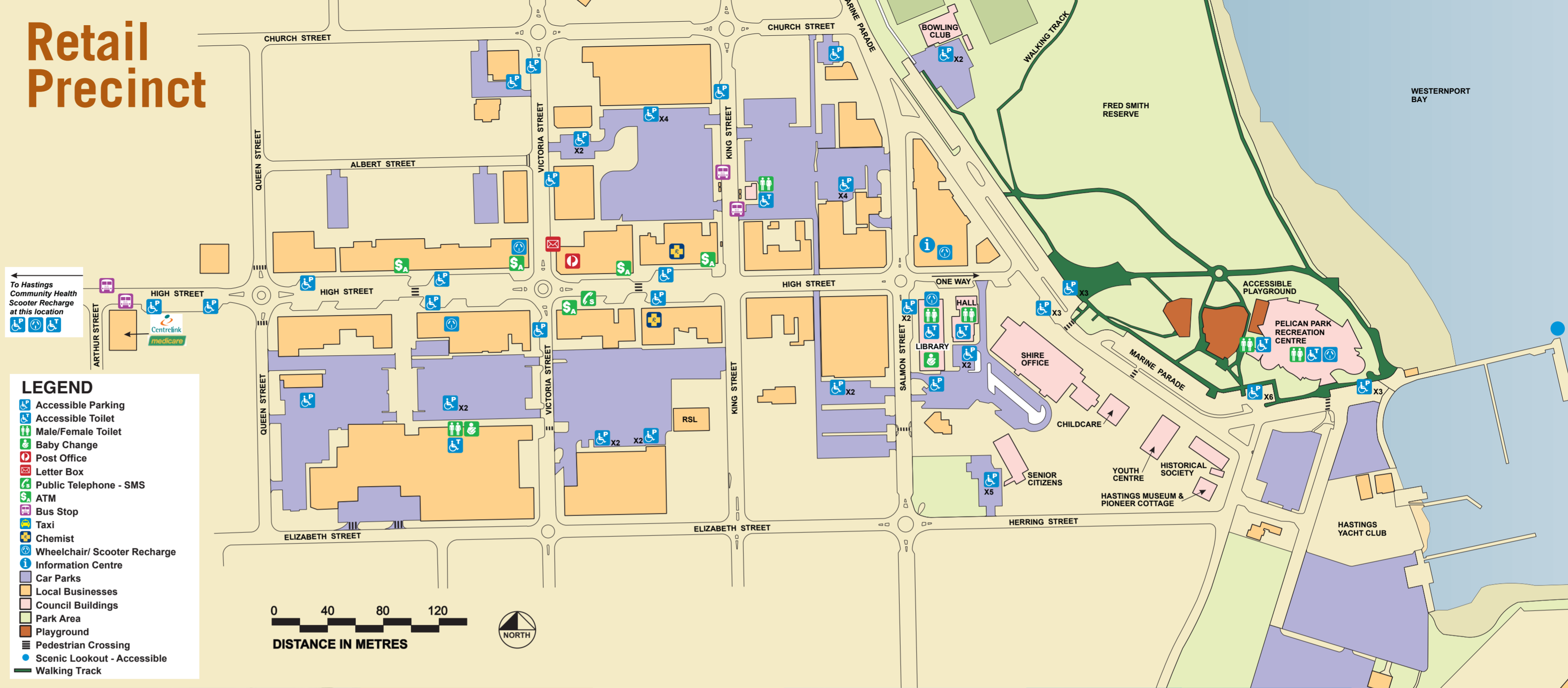

Introduction

Mornington Peninsula Shire is committed to planning for improved access for people who are older, less mobile and people with disabilities.

This mobility map has been produced by the Mornington Peninsula Shire to assist electric scooter and wheelchair users to have access to healthy places and spaces, and participate in their local community.

The map includes accessible information such as where the main shopping areas are located, car parks, accessible toilets, accessible bus stops, taxi ranks, police station and recharge points.

Accessible footpath routes are identified on the map to help electric scooter and wheelchair users to safely plan their trip.

Plan ahead for a safe journey

- Familiarise yourself with the accessible footpaths in your area. Only travel on the road when a continuous path of travel is not available.
- When crossing the road, look for a pedestrian crossing or a place that has easy access with the footpaths directly opposite each other.
- Familiarise yourself with where the Scooter RECHARGE Points are located on your journey.
- Carry a personal identification card with information such as your emergency contact details, physical and medical information, the name of your doctor, etc.
- Take a mobile phone with you in case of an emergency.

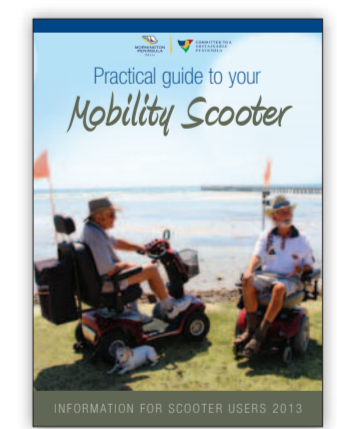
About Hastings
