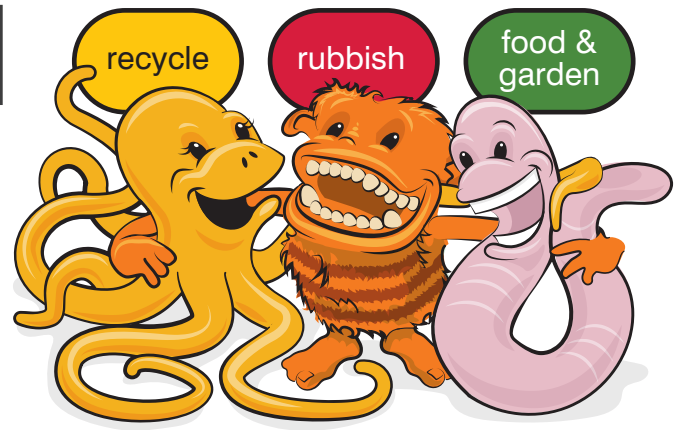


Waste and recycle guide
