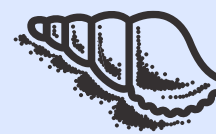

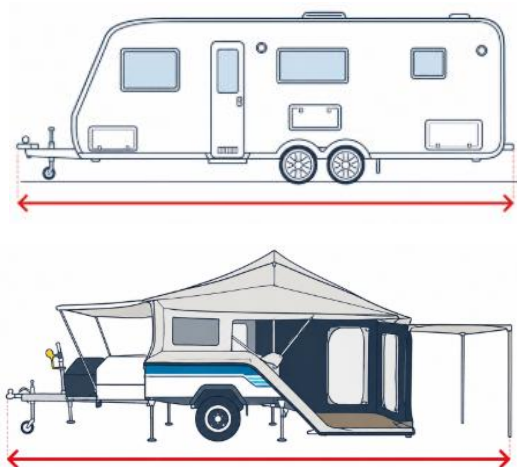

Tips for choosing the right campsite

It's important to measure your set up correctly so that you can comply with the required fire clearance on your site.

- Ensure you know the total footprint of your set-up. Measure the total length from tow ball to rear of your van or trailer, or the full size of tent and vehicle.
- Remember to include all extras; bike racks, spare tyres, drawbars, awnings, annexes, and ropes
- If unsure, choose a slightly larger site but keep in mind that the larger the site you request, the fewer sites will be available to select from.
- Some sites have difficult access and are not suitable for all vehicles, caravans, or camping setups. Be sure to check the site description carefully before booking.

Measuring your set up



Step-by-Step Booking Process

1. To make a booking visit: [Book a campsite - Mornington Peninsula Shire](#)
2. Click on the **BOOK NOW BUTTON**
3. Enter your arrival and departure dates
4. Enter the number of guests (max 6 people per site – with max 4 adults)
5. Select the area you would like to stay (McCrae, Rosebud, Rye, Sorrento) by clicking on **'show accommodation types'**
6. Select the section you want to stay in, for example Section 5 (McCrae)
7. Click on **'Book Now'** to review the section map and available sites (showing with a green dot)
8. Select a site by clicking one of the green dots
9. If the site suits your needs, click on 'confirm site selection' and proceed to checkout.
10. You must check the box to agree to the Conditions of Camping to finalise your booking.
11. Enter your details and complete payment.
12. You will receive a confirmation email. Please check all details thoroughly.
