

Answers to questions asked during the community presentation held before the Council Meeting on 14 November 2023

Potholes

Ms Louise Page asked the following question:

Can you tell me how many potholes were reported during the period July to September 2023?

Council advises:

The Shire is responsible for the maintenance and renewal of around 1,700 kilometres of sealed and unsealed roads across the Mornington Peninsula. In addition to the Shire's responsibilities, there are many other authorities including VicRoads and Committees of Management that have responsibilities in maintaining and repairing roads. The Shire's website [Roads - Mornington Peninsula Shire \(mornpen.vic.gov.au\)](https://www.mornpen.vic.gov.au/roads) has links to check who is the responsible authority for all roads across the Peninsula.

In the July to September 2023 quarter, the Shire's contractors repaired 3,512 potholes on the road network where the Shire is the responsible authority. Our data only covers potholes where the Shire is responsible and where action was undertaken.
