

HOW TO CHECK THE **VACCINATION** STATUS OF INTERNATIONAL **VISITORS**

Visitors aged 18 years and over are required to show proof of vaccination to enter certain businesses or events.

International visitors need **two things** to prove their vaccination status:

1. Evidence of vaccination

This can be either:

a. an Australian International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate

OR

b. a copy of a paper or digital certificate issued by an overseas government authority or an accredited overseas government vaccination provider written in English or accompanied by a certified translation that shows the:

- person's name as it appears in their passport
- person's date of birth or passport number
- Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) approved vaccine brand name
- date of each dose, or the date on which a full course of immunisation was completed

2. Official declaration of vaccination

This can be either:

a. an Australian Traveller Declaration

OR

b. COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing declaration for travel to Australia
